

## Membership fees 2010

We ensure that membership fees are simple, straight forward and have no hidden extras. Our fees are intended to be fair and non discriminatory. Membership is only open to those companies obligated as large portable batteries producers. Small portable batteries producer, automotive batteries producer and industrial batteries producers should all register directly with the EA or BIS as appropriate. The deadline for 2010 large portable batteries producers joining an approved compliance scheme is the 15th October 2009. Please contact Comply Direct if this date has passed and if you are obligated as a large producer of portable batteries.

### Key points regarding membership fees

- The 2010 compliance period runs from 1st Jan 2010 to 31st Dec 2010.
- The deadline for registration for the 2010 compliance period is 15th October 2009 (please contact our team if the deadline has passed).
- A member cannot leave the Comply Direct compliance scheme without giving sufficient resignation notice as per the terms and conditions of batteries membership.

### Batteries recycling fees

Batteries members will be charged portable batteries recycling fees based upon the amount of portable batteries they place on the UK market in 2010 and for which they are obligated. The requirements in 2010 are that obligated producers have a requirement to finance 10% of batteries they place on the market in 2010. For example, if an obligated producer company places 110 tonnes of portable batteries on the market in 2010 it will be responsible to finance 11 tonnes of portable batteries recycling. The recycling fees are structured as follows;

#### Option One

If you are to place between 1 and 5 tonnes of portable batteries onto the UK market in 2010

Portable Battery - Chemistry Type	2010 Charge per tonne of portable batteries placed onto UK market (per tonne)
Nickel-Cadmium (NiCd)	£100 + VAT
Lead (Pb)	£100 + VAT
Others	£100 + VAT

#### Option Two

If you are to place more than 5 tonnes of portable batteries onto the UK market in 2010

Portable Battery - Chemistry Type	2010 Charge per tonne of portable batteries placed onto UK market (per tonne)
Nickel-Cadmium (NiCd)	£95 + VAT
Lead (Pb)	£95 + VAT
Others	£95 + VAT

## Agency Fees

Annual registration fee as laid down by regulations. This is charged at cost by Comply Direct. For large portable batteries:

- £680 (not VAT applicable) for each scheme member

## Late registration fees

All late registration fees and expenses incurred by Comply Direct for handling late registrations will be passed directly back to the member concerned.

## Re-submission fee

If a member has to make a re-submission of their data to the relevant agency via their compliance scheme during a compliance period then any charges incurred by Comply Direct for such re-submission will be passed directly back to the member concerned.

## How to pay

- Comply Direct annual membership fees and relevant agency fees are payable upon application.
- Payment terms for all batteries treatment and recycling fees are 30 days from end of month.
