What is WEEE ?

WEEE stands for 'waste electrical and electronic equipment' and refers to electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) which has come to the end of its life, so has become waste.

To win a prize, all you need to do is collect as many unwanted electricals and textiles you can and bring them onto the estate and place in the special containers provided. For each item of WEEE or bag of textiles, you will receive a raffle ticket to be in with a chance to win a prize. Come to the Comply Direct office to get your tickets.

Example electrical waste items to bring in! Do's and don'ts



Do's (small household items) eg:

- Old toasters / kettles / microwaves
- Broken or unwanted electrical toys / games / games consoles
- Old laptops / mobile phones / tablets
- Lamps / wall or ceiling lights
- Sat-navs / power banks / USB sticks



Don'ts (large household items) eg:

- White goods (washing machines, fridges, freezers etc)
- Cookers or boilers
- TV screens / PC monitor screens

*Any batteries in the items will need to be removed and placed in the separate container, which will also be provided.

Example textiles items to bring in! Do's and don'ts



Do's

- Clothes
- Shoes and Boots
- Bed Linen and Sheets
- Jackets

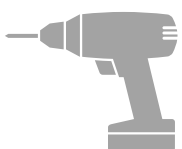


Don'ts (large household items) eg:

- Duvets
- Skates and Rollerblades
- Tents

Location: Broughton Hall Estate, near Skipton.



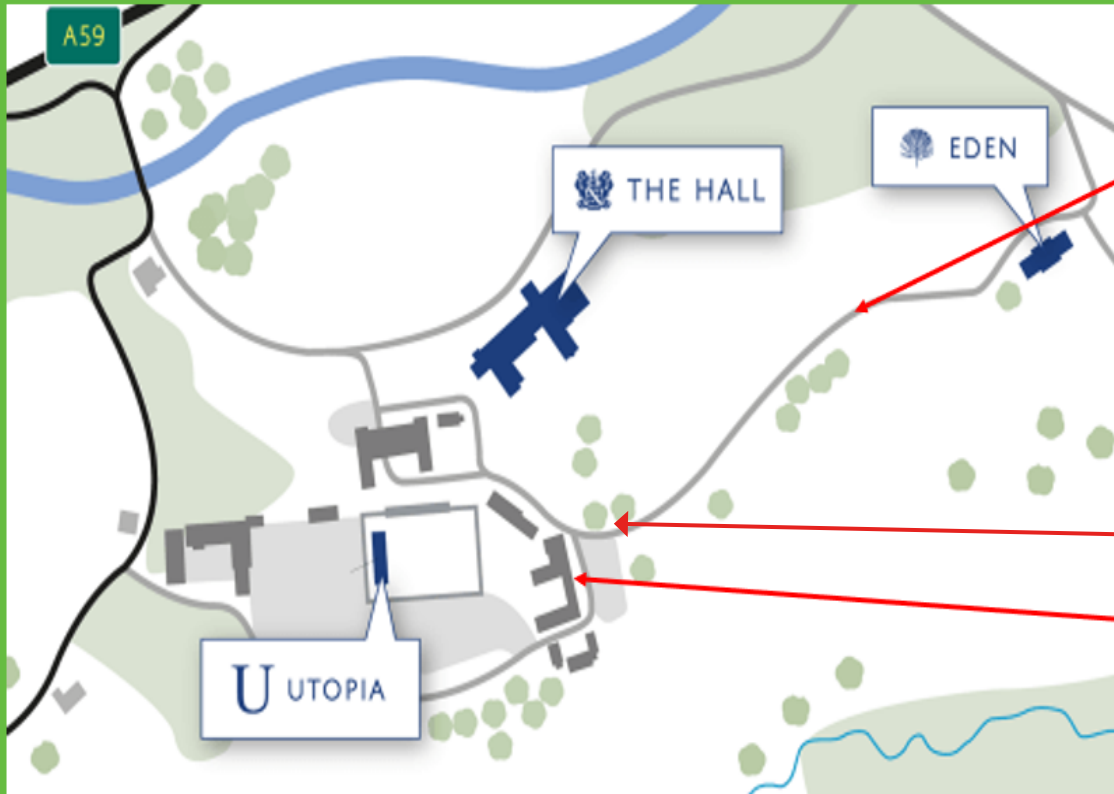

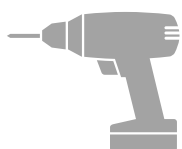
Estate Entrance from A59
